Cumberland Township Board of Supervisors Minutes of the January 4, 2012 Reorganization Meeting

The meeting was called to order at 4:00 p.m. Present were all Supervisors: Mr. David Waybright, Mr. Thomas Shealer, Mrs. Barbara Underwood, Mr. Steve Toddes and Mr. Al Ferranto, Manager Ben Thomas, Jr. Assistant Secretary Carol Merryman and Police Chief Don Boehs. Mrs. Underwood made a motion seconded by Mr. Shealer and carried to appoint Mr. Thomas Acting Chair.

Mr. Thomas asked for a nomination for Chair. Mr. Waybright nominated Mrs. Underwood for Chair. There were no other nominations. Mr. Shealer made a motion to close the nominations seconded by Mr. Toddes and carried. Mr. Thomas asked the secretary to cast the ballot nominating Barbara Underwood as Chairperson to the Board of Supervisors for 2012.

Chairperson Underwood presided over the rest of the meeting.

Mr. Ferranto stated that he would like all meetings to be held at night so residents who work can attend. After some discussion; Mr. Waybright made a motion to have the regular meeting on the fourth Tuesday of each month January through November and December 18, 2012 at 7:00 p.m. and the first workshop on the Thursday preceding the 2nd Tuesday at 7:00 p.m. (if needed) and the second workshop on the Thursday preceding the 4th Tuesday at 8:30 a.m. seconded by Mr. Toddes and carried.

Mr. Shealer made a motion seconded by Mr. Waybright and carried to retain ACNB Bank as depositor for the Township's funds.

Mr. Waybright made a motion seconded by Mr. Toddes and carried to bond the Manager, Treasurer, and Assistant Treasurer for 1,100,000.00 for each.

Mr. Waybright made a motion seconded by Mr. Shealer to authorize Supervisors and appropriate staff to attend the Pennsylvania State Association of Township Supervisors (PSATS) Annual Educational Conference May 6 - 9, 2012. Mr. Ferranto asked for the cost of the conference. Mr. Thomas reported that it is \$140.00 for early registration.

Mr. Waybright made a motion seconded by Mr. Shealer and carried to reappoint Barry Stone and Dennis Hickethier to four-year terms on the Planning Commission ending 12/31/2015.

Mr. Waybright made a motion seconded by Mr. Shealer and carried to appoint Bobby Rohrbaugh to the Zoning Hearing Board for a three-year term expiring 12/31/2014.

** The condition of the plan is such that contributions may be reduced, or eliminated, as evidenced by an actuarial study;

** Municipal contributions will not be required to keep the fund actuarially sound;

** The governing body of the Municipality eliminates contributions on an annual basis.
