Subject: 2026 Budget

A municipal budget is arguably the most important policy document a local government produces, serving as a comprehensive financial, legal, and operational blueprint for Cumberland Township. It allocates a community's resources to essential services like public safety and infrastructure. It authorizes local officials to spend funds, ensures the municipality can meet its obligations, and reflects the community's priorities for the upcoming year. Essentially, the budget is the primary tool for a municipality to implement the Township's vision and plan the future.

The proposed 2026 budget has taken into consideration Income, Fixed Expenses, Debt, Flexible and Unplanned Expenses, and Savings. It is recommended to increase the Cumberland Township Millage by .5%. This budget will guide the Township in its service delivery while it also reflects the Townships priorities, authorizes spending, ensures financial stability, and acts as a management and planning tool.

A property with an assessed value of \$269,911.12 (the average value in the Township) would realize an increase of \$11.25 per month.

The last adjustment made to the Cumberland Township municipal tax was in 2018. Current driving factors are inflation, 50% rise in healthcare since 2021, and increased staffing costs to continue to provide the services our community knows and expects.

I would like to thank the Supervisors, Staff, and Committees for all their efforts for the past eight years. Cumberland Township will continue to be financially accountable for every dollar collected while providing the services that Cumberland Township residents have become accustomed to relying on every day.

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

### Average Cumberland Township Staffing Overview







### OPERATING RESERVE FUND

the Operating Reserve Account can be replenished from revenues within the same budget year. results in current regular, budgeted expenditures outstripping current, regular budgeted revenue in a given month. Therefore, an Operating revenue stream is not constant; tax revenue is remitted to the Township intermittently in large amounts. This intermittent revenue stream potential service disruption in the event of unexpected temporary revenue shortfalls or unpredicted one-time expenditures. The Township's The Township maintains a prudent level of operating financial reserves to ensure continued operations of the Township and mitigate Reserve Account is necessary to ensure that adequate cash is on hand to meet regular and budgeted expenditure needs until such time as

Operating Reserve Account shall not be used to balance the budget during the annual budgetary process and provide a contingency in the event of a bona fide emergency or unforeseen revenue shortfall. It is a cash flow management tool. The Account is not to accumulate funds for capital projects, rather, its purpose is to ensure that operations can be sustained during revenue ebbs The Operating Reserve Account is not to be considered a capital reserve or investment account. The purpose of the Operating Reserve

Bona fide emergencies and unforeseen revenue shortfalls may include circumstances similar to the following:

Extreme weather events that damage Township infrastructure

An emergency response event that requires manpower and resources far beyond what could be anticipated in the respective emergency service department budgets

The closure of a major employer that significantly impacts revenue sources.

The Operating Reserve Account shall not be used for any of the following:


- \* Provide resources for one-time capital outlay expenditures which include capital equipment as part of a capital initiative.
